




SPB no.1 - Card 70x20 mm2 - On the back INFN Roma1 2001 SMD resistors are ~ 1mm thick




SPB no.2 - Card 70x20 mm2 - On the back LNF SPB3 NEW Apr 2002 SMD resistors are ~ 1mm thick Apparently R equal to spb no.1




SPB no.3 - Card 70x20 mm2 - On the back LNF SPB3 NEW Apr 2002 SMD resistors are ~ 0.5 mm thick Apparently R is NOT equal to spb no.1 or 2




SPB no.4 - Card 63x20 mm2 – Wire readout - On the back LNF SPB3 ALL Dic 2003 SMD resistors are ~ 0.5 mm thick Logo of resistor not equal to spb no.3 Only one found in Frascati chambers (up to now)



SPB no.5 - Card 63x20 mm2 – Wire readout - On the back LNF SPB3 ALL Dic 2003 SMD resistors are ~ 0.5 mm thick Logo of resistor not equal to spb no.3 All Frascati chambers have these !



SPB no.6 - Card 63x20 mm2 – Pad readout SMD resistors are ~ 0.5 mm thick Only one found in Frascati Apparently same R type of spb no.3



SPB no.7 - Card 63x20 mm2 – Pad readout SMD resistors are ~ 0.5 mm thick All Frascati chambers have these !
