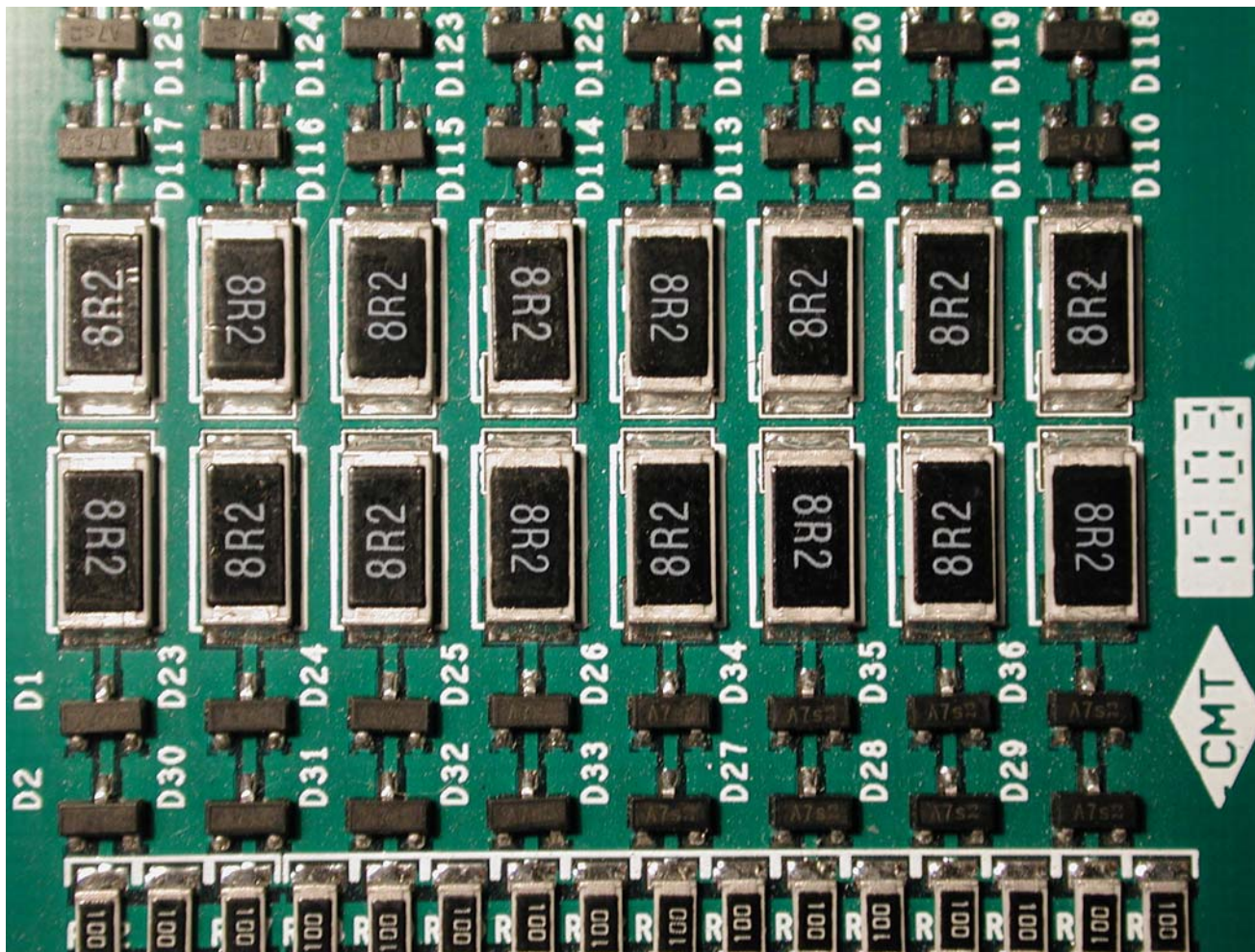


SPB no.1 - Card 70x20 mm² - On the back
INFN Roma1 2001

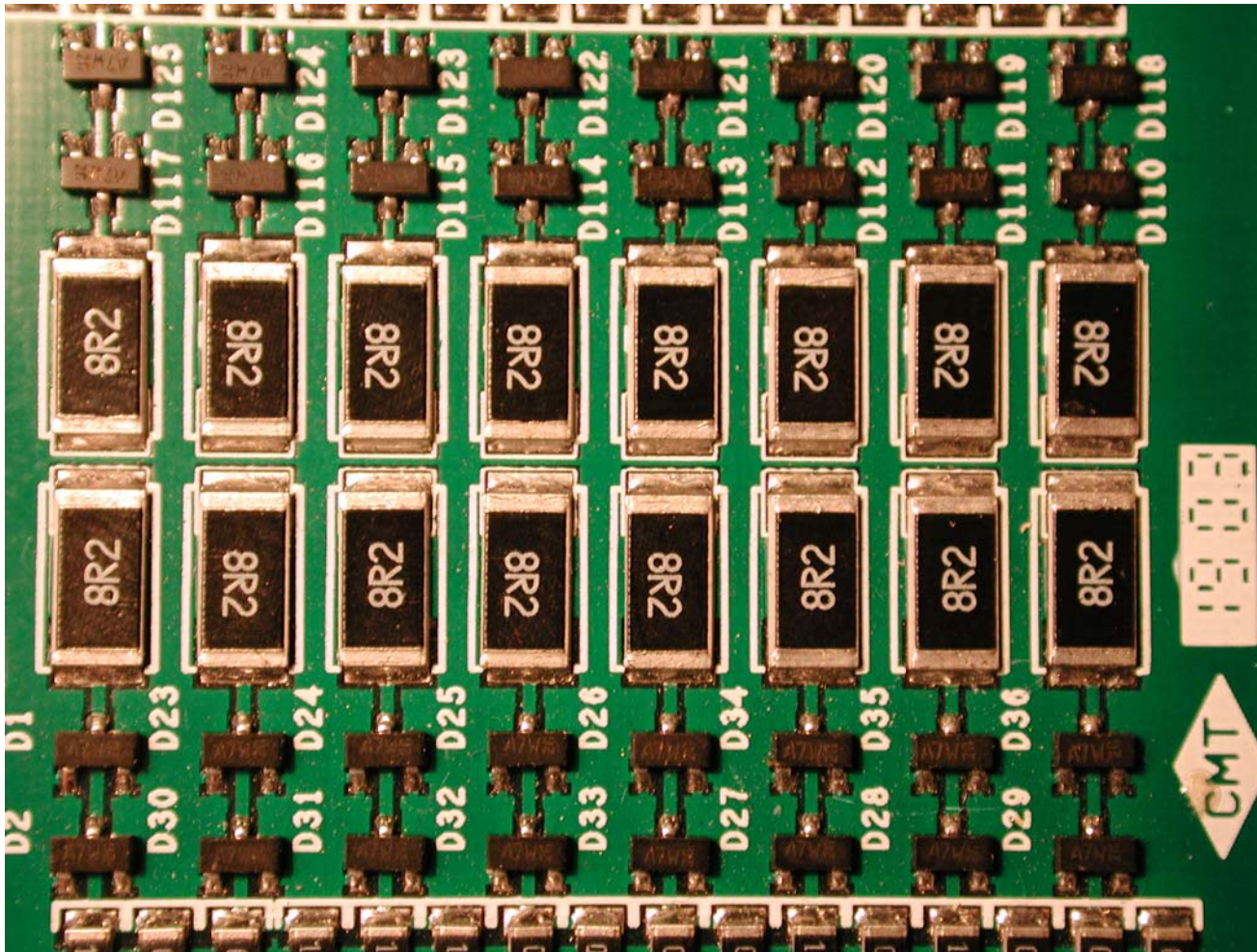
SMD resistors are ~ 1mm thick



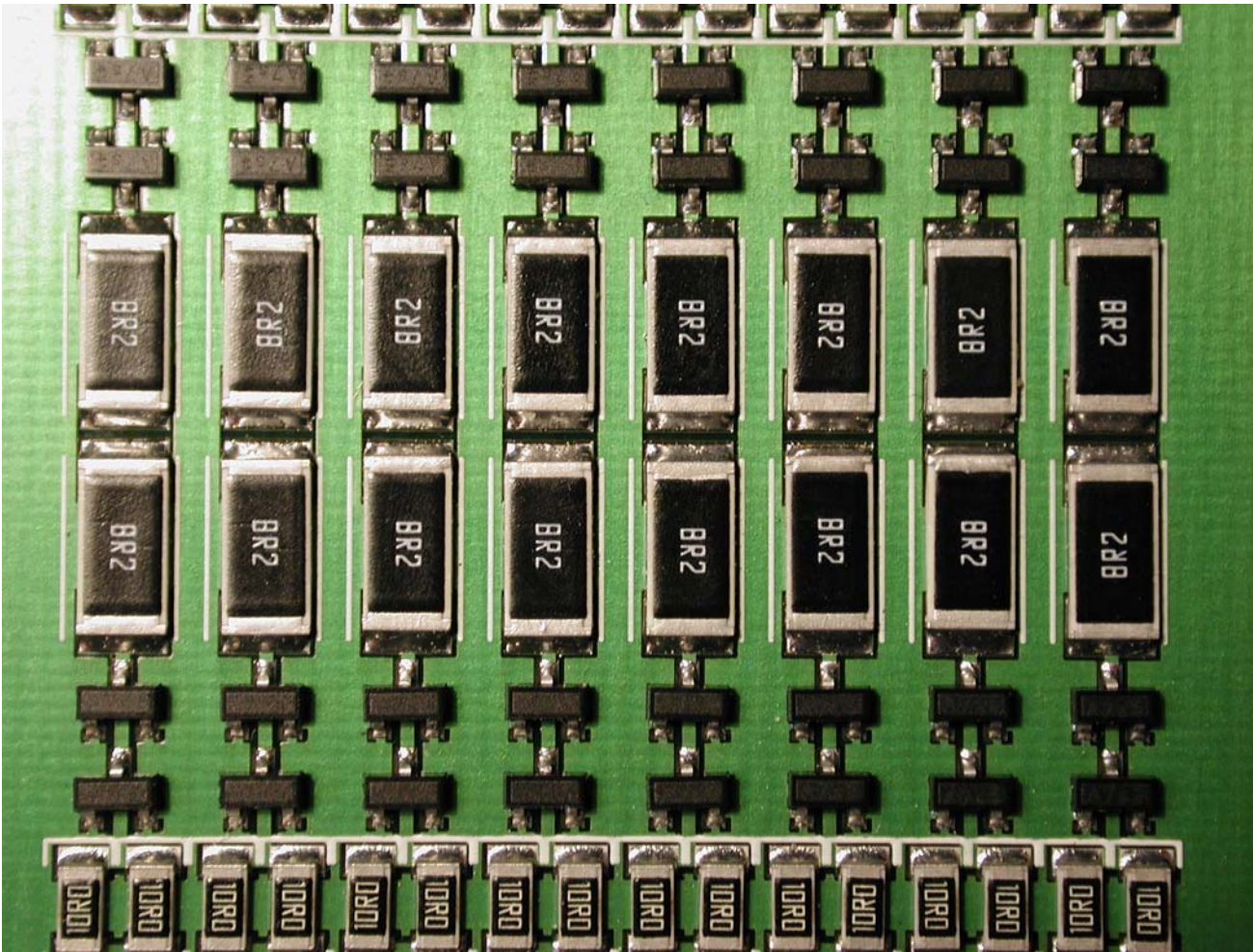
SPB no.2 - Card 70x20 mm² - On the back

SMD resistors are ~ 0.5 mm thick
Apparently R is NOT equal to spb no.1 or 2

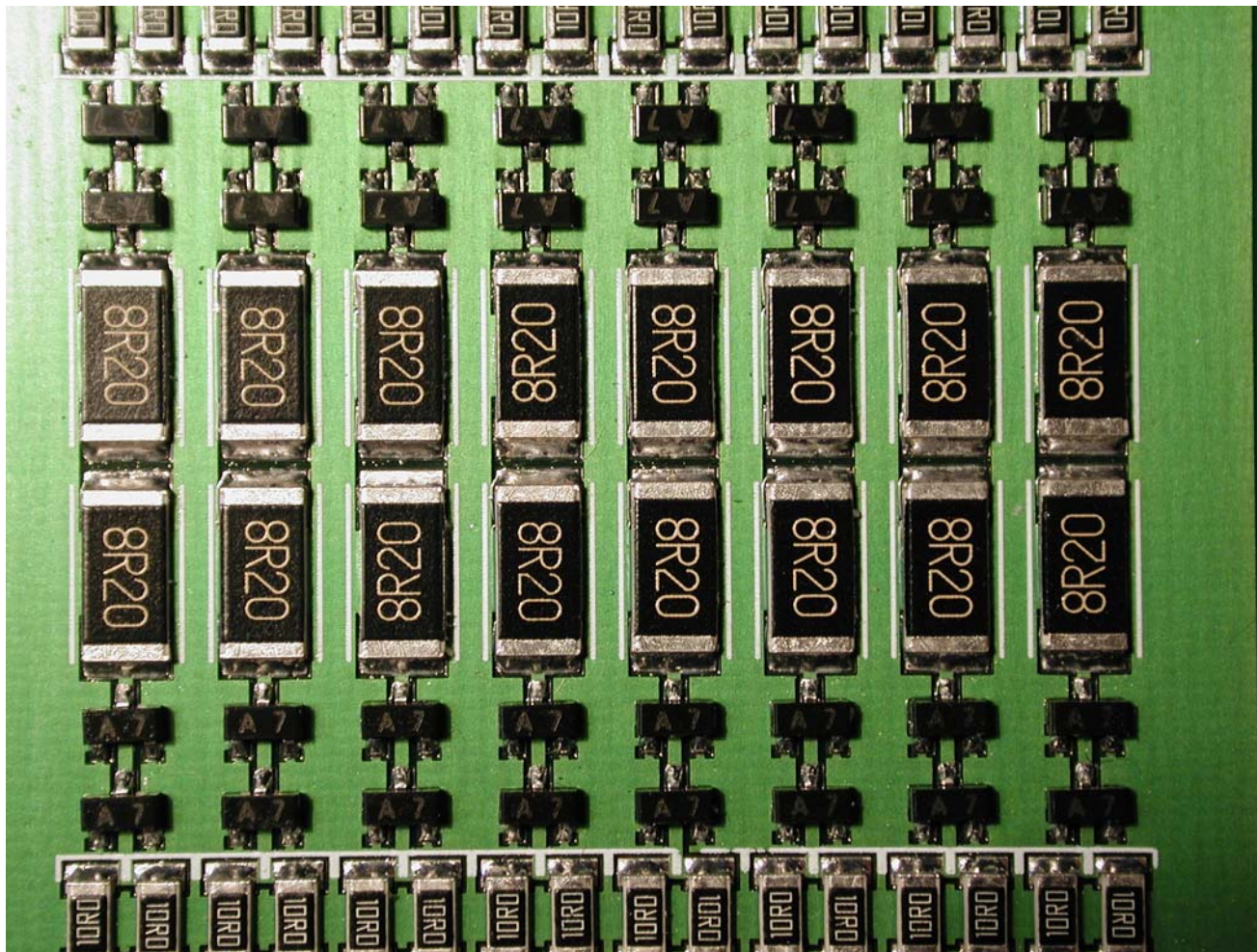


SPB no.4 - Card 63x20 mm² – Wire readout - On the back

SMD resistors are ~ 0.5 mm thick

Only one found in Frascati chambers (up to now)

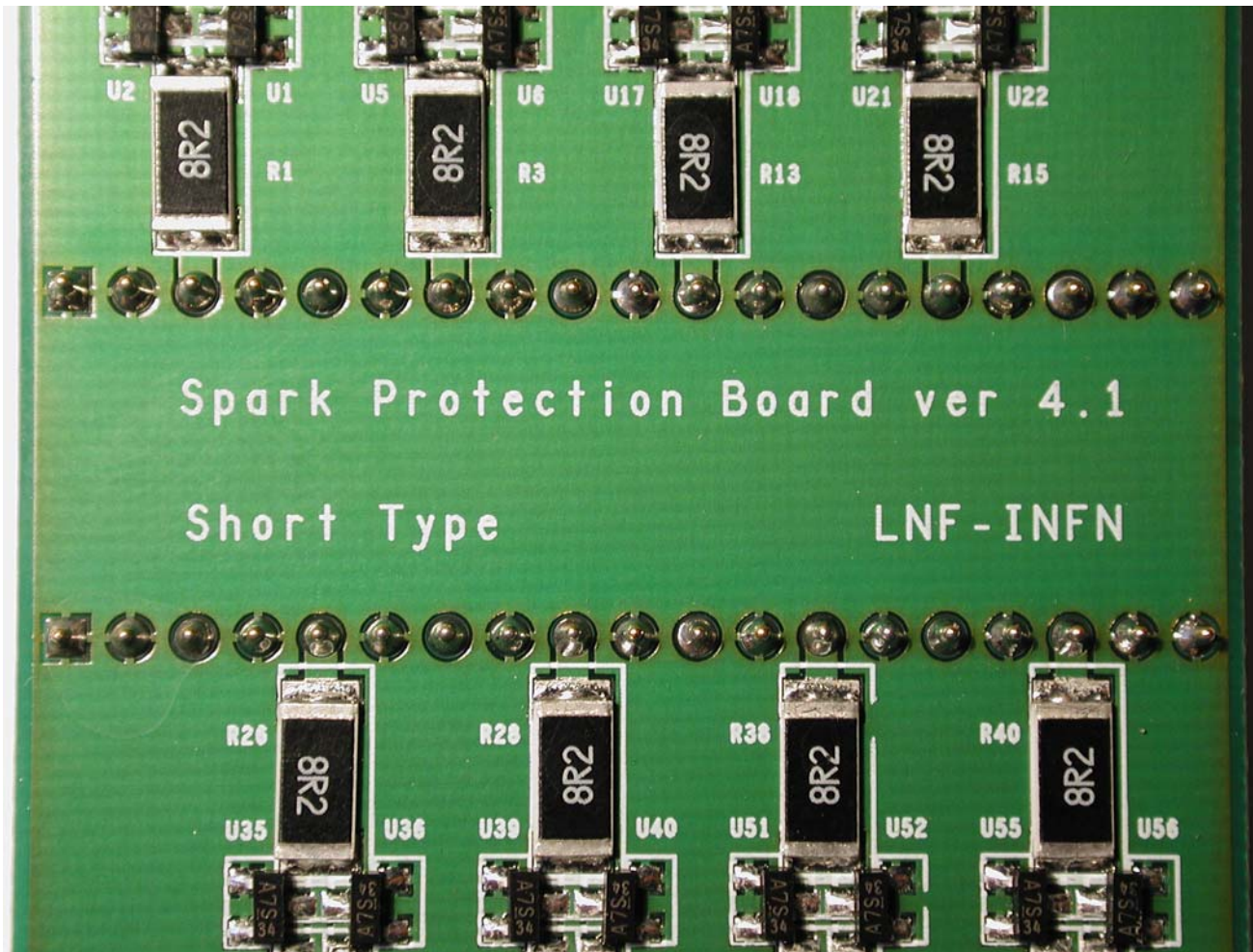


SPB no.5 - Card 63x20 mm² – Wire readout - On the back
LNF SPB3 ALL Dic 2003

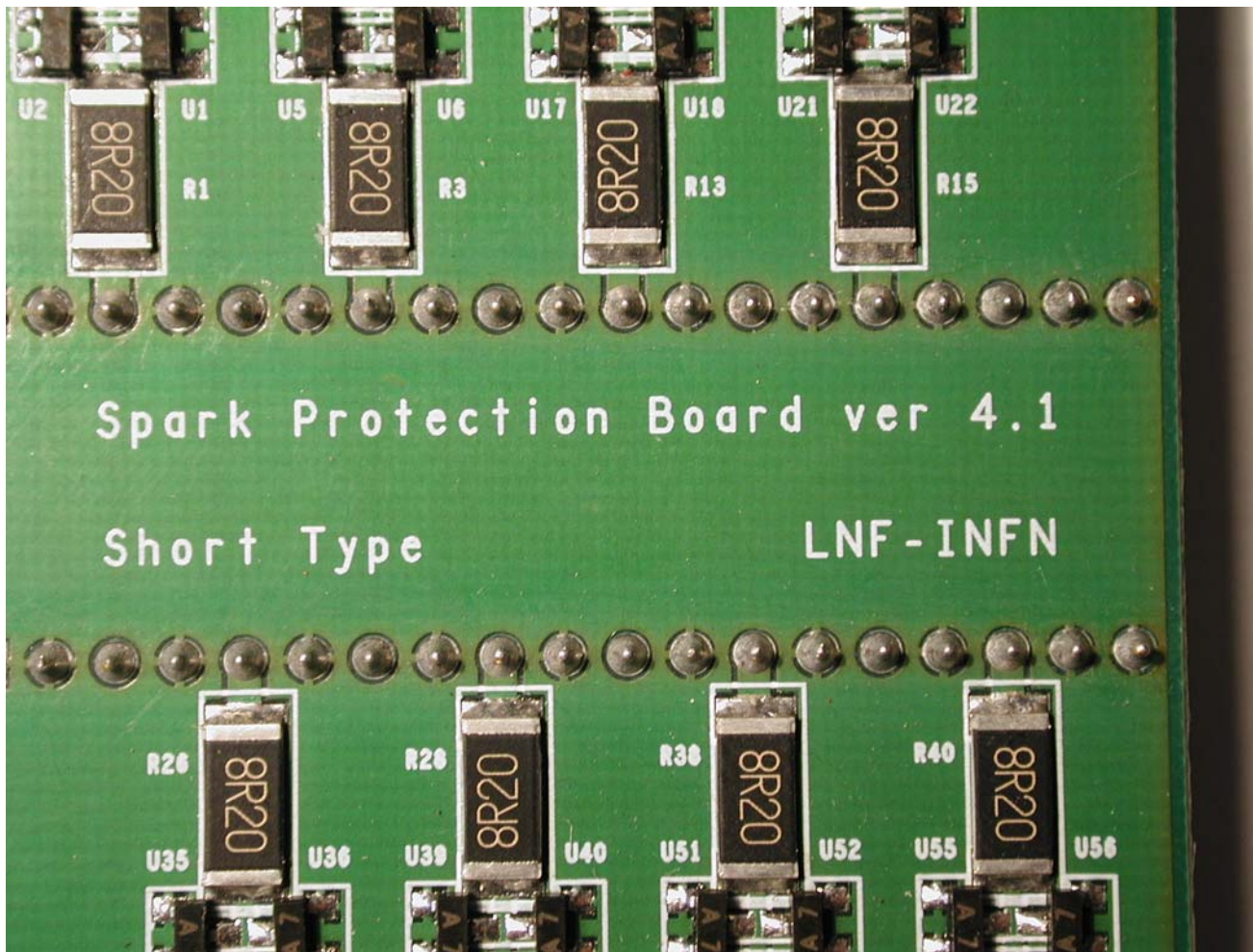
SMD resistors are ~ 0.5 mm thick

Apparently same R type of spb no.3
